REPORT ON MEDICAL CAMP- 28.11.2025

A free Medical Camp was organized on 28.11.2025 at GPTC, Vanavasi with the objective of providing healthcare services to students and staff. The National Service Scheme (NSS), Youth Red Cross (YRC) and Red Ribbon Club (RRC) units of GPTC, Vanavasi organized the Camp in collaboration with Primary Health Centre, Nangavalli.

The event was inaugurated by our college Principal Dr. M.VARATHAGURU and Vice-Principal of our college Dr. S. MURUGESAN. The program was organized by Mr. D. THANGAMANI, Lecturer in Physics / NSS Co-Ordinator (Unit 1) and Mr. M. VADIVEL, Lecturer in Mathematics/ NSS Co-Ordinator (Unit 2). The camp aimed to create awareness about general health issues, offer basic diagnostic services and guide students toward proper treatment and preventive measures.

The following medical services were provided during the medical camp:

1. General Health Check-up
2. Blood pressure and Diabetes Screening
3. Basic Laboratory Tests (Hb, Blood Sugar)
4. Distribution of Medicines
5. Health Awareness and Counselling Sessions

The Medical Camp at our college benefitted 900 students and 60 staff members and focused on general health check-ups, early diagnosis and health awareness.
